OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

GREENTOWN'S BRUCE KING TO BE HONORED WITH GIRLS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2023-24 IHSAA Outstanding Girls Soccer Official in the state of Indiana is Bruce King from Greentown, Indiana. Bruce was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana.

There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.

King has been licensed in the sport of soccer for 24 years and has been a crew member for 19 different sectionals, 16 different regionals, 13 semi-state games, and has had six (6) state finals appearances, in 2009, 2010, 2012, 2015, 2018, and 2021!

Bruce is a member of the North Central Officials Association and has served as the Soccer Program Chair for the past 10 years. He also volunteers as an IHSAA Rules Interpreter, helping his fellow officials and soccer coaches understand the various rules of the game, and as an IHSAA Clinician, providing training and lessons to officials in his community.

On the side, Bruce works as an assigner for several middle schools and soccer clubs in his area, connecting the schools/clubs with officials to work their soccer matches. This has helped him meet new officials and help them develop as a mentor. He often seeks out the help of student-athletes and enjoys getting them interested in officiating.

Bruce resides in Greentown, Indiana with his wife and, together, they have two children. He has worked as an engineer for 38 years and currently works for BAE Systems in Fort Wayne.

- Canterbury playing in second consecutive state championship match and fourth in the last 10 years. Cavaliers playing for third state championship.
- Team returned nine starters from last year's state runner-up outfit.
- This contest is a rematch of last year's title contest won by Park Tudor 3-0 and the fifth championship rematch for the 1A girls trophy.
- Second meeting of the season with Park Tudor following a 3-1 defeat on a neutral field on Sept. 2.
- The loss to Park Tudor started a slide of six straight losses to much larger schools but Cavaliers have won six straight to reach the final match.
- Beat one ranked team during this state tournament: def. #8 Westview 3-1 to seal the semi-state championship on Saturday.
- Dropped a 3-0 decision at home to 2A state finalist Leo on Aug. 19.
- After seven years at her alma mater Shelbyville, head coach Chelsea Dourson has guided Canterbury to the title match in both of her two seasons in charge. She is a first grade teacher at the Canterbury Lower School.
